279 VolunTeens volunteered **7,596** hours at various Y locations.

**5,567** families received food, **211,751** meals at a total of 4,235,020 lbs. of food in partnership with the SA Food Bank.

**179** Teens competed in the Y Youth & Government program (highest enrollment ever), with 141 advancing to State Conference.

3,327 Individuals took life-saving swim lessons at the Y & 550 children received water safety skills in partnership with learning, summer San Antonio ISD.

**18.124** infants and children participated in Y Youth Development programs (after school, early day camp, youth sports).
